An economist who works as a researcher at IDEA CERGE-EI think-tank in Prague and as a lecturer at Charles University, Prague. He specializes in international trade theory, economics of transition and Chinese economy, his latest research concerns the debt crisis, Sino-EU trade relations and estimates of effects of trade liberalization between EU and the USA. Vilem studied at Prague University of Economics (VŠE Praha), London School of Economics & Political Science (LSE), and Charles University (IES and CERGE-EI); obtained Ph.D. degree from the Prague University of Economics in 2003. He also experienced several longer work- and research-related stays in China (P.R.C.).
